第一條、宗旨

電機工程學系系友會(以下簡稱本會)為回饋電機工程學系(以下簡稱母系)之栽培以及增進本會與母系在校生之情誼，鼓勵母系在校學弟妹積極協助參與系上及系友會各項活動、熱心公益並關懷社會，特訂定本辦法。

第二條、獎助學金之名額及金額

本獎助學金分為九部分：

- (一) 菁英獎學金：為獎勵本國學生修讀全英語授課課程以增強其國際化能力，以母系大學部一年級及二年級在學生，每學期以各十名為原則，每名金額新台幣三千元整。
- (二) 傑出獎學金：為獎勵參與國家級或國際性專業競賽獲得傑出表現學生之用途，以母系大學部及研究所在學生共三名為原則(必要時得從缺)，每名金額新台幣五萬元整。
- (三) 超群獎學金：為獎勵參與校外專業競賽獲得傑出表現學生之用途，以母系大學部及研究所在學生共三名為原則(必要時得從缺)，每名金額新台幣三萬元整。
- (四) 優秀獎學金：獎勵優秀學生之用途，以母系大學部每年級各二名、碩博士班共四名，總名額共十二名為原則，每名金額新台幣壹萬元整(以未獲其他獎助學金者為優先)。
- (五) 專題競賽獎學金：為獎助專題製作競賽之用途，取參賽團隊特優四名、優等四名、佳作八名為原則(必要時得從缺)，特優每名新台幣一萬元整，優等每名新台幣五千元整，佳作每名新台幣三千元整。
- (六) 安心就學助學金：為協助遭遇重大急難事故之學生安心就學，每位學生每月至多補助 5,000 元整，獲獎助者需每月至系所擔任志工 16 小時為原則，協助系上及本會相關事務，每次核定最多為 3 個月。
- (七) 一般工讀助學金：依勞動部規定標準發給。
- (八) 大一至大四學雜費減免助學金：每學期補助總金額新台幣四萬五千元整為上限，並視學生名額分配補助經費，若有休學者，復學後停止補助。
- (九) 國際交流助學金：每年補助總金額新台幣六萬元整為上限並視申請名額分配補助經費，若有休學者，復學後停止補助。

第三條、申請資格

第二條各項申請資格如下：

1. 第(一)項限母系大學部在籍之本國學生。
2. 第(二)~(六)項限母系大學部、碩士班及博士班在籍學生。
3. 第(七)項限本校在籍大學部與碩士班學生。
4. 第(八)項限母系 104 學年度起大學部甲組入學在籍學生，且僅減免第一學期至第八學期學雜費用，若有休學者，復學後喪失大學部甲組資格。
5. 第(九)項限母系大學部甲組入學在籍學生，每人僅限申請一次為限，若有休學者，復學後喪失大學部甲組資格。

第四條、申請條件

1. 菁英獎學金：(必須同時符合下列之條件，並願意配合協助本會舉辦相關活動者優先核給)
 1. 前一學期系必修應全數修習母系全英語授課課程，且不得於學期中辦理棄選。
 2. 前一學期所選科目學分數達 15 學分以上。
 3. 前一學期學業平均成績(GPA)達 3.38 以上。
 4. 前一學期操行成績達 A- 以上，且未受處分及無曠課紀錄。
 5. 應達到下列語言測驗門檻之一：
 - (1) 全民英檢(GEPT)中高級複試通過。
 - (2) 多益(TOEIC)聽力與閱讀測驗 785 分。
 - (3) 托福紙筆測驗(TOEFL ITP)543 分。
 - (4) 托福網路測驗(TOEFL iBT)72 分。
 - (5) 雅思國際英語測驗(IELTS)5.5 級。
 6. 除不可抗力因素外，應親自出席獎學金頒發典禮。
2. 傑出獎學金：(必須同時符合下列之條件，並願意配合協助本會舉辦相關活動者優先核給)
 1. 參加國家級或國際性專業競賽獲獎，事蹟於申請前已提報母系公告，並經母系獎學金委員會認可之傑出事蹟；若為團體競賽則每案以一人一次為限，申請人必須檢附團隊其他成員的放棄申請聲明書(申請者可同時勾選優秀獎學金項目，若未入選本項獎學金可自動併入優秀獎學金申請審查名單)。
 2. 前兩學期學業平均成績(GPA)達 2.44 以上(一年級：前一學期成績)。
 3. 前兩學期操行成績達 B 以上(一年級：前一學期成績)。
 4. 除不可抗力因素外，應親自出席獎學金頒發典禮。
3. 超群獎學金：(必須同時符合下列之條件，並願意配合協助本會舉辦相關活動者優先核給)
 1. 參加校外專業競賽獲獎，事蹟於申請前已提報母系公告，並經母系獎學金委員會認可之傑出事蹟；若為團體競賽則每案以一人一次為限，申請人必須檢附團隊其他成員的放棄申請聲明書(申請者可同時勾選優秀獎學金項目，若未入選本項獎學金可自動併入優秀獎學金申請審查名單)。
 2. 前兩學期學業平均成績(GPA)達 2.44 以上(一年級：前一學期成績)。
 3. 前兩學期操行成績達 B 以上(一年級：前一學期成績)。
 4. 除不可抗力因素外，應親自出席獎學金頒發典禮。
4. 優秀獎學金：(必須同時符合下列之條件，並願意配合協助本會舉辦相關活動者優先核給)
 1. 對社會或母系熱心服務或有傑出貢獻者，包含擔任班級幹部及系學會幹部。
 2. 前兩學期學業平均成績(GPA)達 2.44 以上(一年級：前一學期成績)。
 3. 前兩學期操行成績達 B 以上(一年級：前一學期成績)。
 4. 除不可抗力因素外，應親自出席獎學金頒發典禮。
5. 專題競賽獎學金：(必須同時符合下列之條件)
 1. 依母系制訂之專題製作競賽辦法相關規定辦理。
 2. 除不可抗力因素外，應親自出席獎學金頒發典禮。
6. 安心就學助學金：(必須同時符合下列之條件)
 1. 具服務熱忱經導師查核並以書面文件確認需要短期協助者為原則。
 2. 可排班協助系上及本會進行校友連繫及系友會會務運作業務者
7. 一般工讀助學金：具服務熱忱者。
8. 大一至大四學雜費減免助學金：前一學期學業平均成績(GPA)2.85(含)以上，入學第一學期則免附學業平均成績。
9. 國際交流助學金：前三學期學業平均成績(GPA)達 2.44(含)以上。

第五條、申請方式

申請者應填寫申請表(如附件，可逕向系辦承辦人索取)，在規定期限內連同下列申請文件送交系辦承辦人，逾期不受理。

1. 成績單正本。
2. 參加國家級、國際性或校外專業競賽獲獎證明(若為團體競賽則申請人必須檢附團隊其他成員的放棄申請聲明書)，或對本會或母系熱心服務、協助舉辦或參與相關活動、或有傑出貢獻之證明文件(由本會、各班導師、系主任、母系或母校所開立之證明文件或證書)。
3. 其他有助於審核之文件。

(四) 菁英獎學金：相關語言檢定測驗成績單。

(五) 大一至大四學雜費減免助學金：逕由母系檢附當學期學雜等繳費單據。

(六) 國際交流助學金：須附向各國外大學申請短期研修、向本校國際處申請交換生或其他相關證明文件。

第六條、申請期限

1. 菁英獎學金：依母系每學期公告時程辦理。

2. 傑出獎學金：於每年2月中~3月初期間提出申請。

3. 超群獎學金：於每年2月中~3月初期間提出申請。

4. 優秀獎學金：於每年2月中~3月初期間提出申請。

5. 專題競賽獎學金：依母系相關規定辦理。

6. 安心就學助學金：依母系相關規定辦理。

7. 一般工讀助學金：依母系需要辦理。

8. 大一至大四學雜費減免助學金：依母系每學期審查核定時程辦理。

9. 國際交流助學金：限該生第四學期或第六學期之3月15日前提出申請。

第七條、評選方式

1. 菁英獎學金：由本會授權母系系主任召集成立審查委員會(含系友會代表一人)，進行審查評選。

2. 傑出獎學金：由本會授權母系系主任召集成立審查委員會(含系友會代表一人)，進行審查評選。

3. 超群獎學金：由本會授權母系系主任召集成立審查委員會(含系友會代表一人)，進行審查評選。

4. 優秀獎學金：由本會授權母系系主任召集成立審查委員會(含系友會代表一人)，進行審查評選。

5. 專題競賽獎學金：依母系相關規定辦理。

6. 安心就學助學金：由系主任審核。

7. 大一至大四學雜費減免助學金：由系主任審核。

8. 國際交流助學金：由本會授權母系系主任召集成立審查委員會(含系友會代表一人)，進行審查核定。

9. 上述獎學金以不重複領取其他獎學金為原則。

第八條、頒發方式

1. 獎學金部份：本會於畢業典禮或其他公開場合頒發獎學金及獎狀，予以表揚。
2. 助學金部份：依每月協助本會工作情形，按月發給學生。
3. 大一至大四學雜費減免助學金：每學期逕由母系辦理核銷手續。
4. 國際交流助學金：獲獎者請於核定時間出國，並於完成出國交換或短期研修返國後，檢附申請項目之單據與完成交換學習或短期研修之相關證明文件辦理核銷。

第九條、本辦法經本會理監事聯席會議通過後實施，修正時亦同。

Article 1 Objective

The Department of Electrical Engineering Alumni Association Board of National Sun Yat-sen University (hereinafter referred to as the Association) has established to repay the cultivation of the Department of Electrical Engineering (hereinafter referred to as the Department) and to enhance the friendship between the Association and the students, and to encourage the students to actively participate in the activities of the Department and the Association, to be enthusiastic about public welfare and to care about the society.

Article 2 The quota and amount of the scholarship

The scholarship includes nine parts:

1. Elite Scholarship: To encourage domestic students taking EMI courses to enhance global perspectives, this scholarship is open to first- and second-year undergraduate students from the Department with a total of ten students per semester. The award amount is NT\$3,000 per student.
2. Exceptional Scholarship: To encourage students for outstanding performance in national or international professional competitions, the amount of the scholarship is NT\$50,000 per student with a total of three students in the Department. If necessary, there will be vacancies.
3. Outstanding Scholarship: To encourage students for outstanding performance in off-campus professional competitions, the amount of the scholarship is NT\$30,000 per student with a total of three students in the Department. If necessary, there will be vacancies.
4. Excellent Scholarship: To encourage students for outstanding performance including two students from the Bachelor's degree program, four students from the Master's and Doctoral degree programs each year with a total of twelve students, the amount of the scholarship is NT\$10,000 per student. Priority will be given to those who have not received any scholarships.
5. Project-Oriented Competition Scholarship: To encourage students for participating in the College of Engineering Project-Oriented Competition, the scholarships will be awarded to the four for the best, four for second place, and eight for third place. If necessary, there will be vacancies. The best work will be awarded in the amount of NT\$10,000 each student, NT\$5,000 for each second place, and NT\$2,000 for each third place.
6. Study Subsidy: To assist students in major emergencies to attend school with peace of mind, each student shall receive a maximum subsidy of NT\$5,000 per month, and the recipient is required to volunteer sixteen hours per month at the department office to assist in departmental and the

- Association matters. The scholarship is granted for a maximum duration of three months.
7. Work-Study Grants: Payments are provided in accordance with the standards set by the Ministry of Labor.
 8. Tuition and Fees Waiver for Freshmen to Seniors: The maximum amount of grants is NT\$45,000 per semester, and the grants shall be allocated based on the number of students. The grants shall be halted when the awarded students resume their study from suspension.
 9. International Exchange Grants: The maximum amount of grants is NT\$60,000 per semester, and the grants shall be allocated based on the number of students. The grants shall be halted when the awarded students resume their study from suspension.

Article 3 Eligibility

The eligibility provisions of Article 2 are as follows:

6. Paragraph 1 is limited to domestic students enrolled in the Bachelor's program in the Department.
7. Paragraph 2 to Paragraph 6 are limited to students enrolled in the Bachelor's program, Master's program and Doctoral program in the Department.
8. Paragraph 7 is limited to students enrolled in the Bachelor's program and Master's program in the University.
9. Paragraph 8 is limited to students enrolled in Class Jia(甲) from the 104 academic year onward and the waiver shall be subject to the first to the eighth semesters. Students who resume study from suspension are disqualified as a student in Class Jia(甲).
10. Paragraph 9 is limited to students enrolled in Class Jia(甲) and they shall apply no more than once. Students who resume study from suspension are disqualified as a student in Class Jia(甲).

Article 4 Application requirements

10. Elite Scholarship: (Priority will be given to those who meet all the following criteria and are willing to assist the Association in organizing related activities.)
 - (1) All required departmental EMI courses shall be completed. Withdrawal of the courses during the semester is not allowed.
 - (2) The total credits of taken courses of the previous semester shall be no more than fifteen.
 - (3) The student's GPA must be above 3.38.
 - (4) The student's conduct performance of the previous semester shall be more than a rank of A- with no punishment or absence records.
 - (5) One of the following requirements shall be met:
 - (a) Passing the GEPT second stage at the high-intermediate level
 - (b) TOEIC Listening and Reading Test 785
 - (c) TOEFL ITP 543
 - (d) TOEFL iBT 72
 - (e) IELTS 5.5
 - (6) Scholarship recipients are required to attend the award ceremony in person, unless prevented by force majeure.
11. Exceptional Scholarship: (Priority will be given to those who meet all the following criteria and are willing to assist the Association in organizing related activities.)
 - (1) Recipients of awards in national or international professional competitions, whose achievements have been previously reported and announced by the Department before the application, and recognized by the department's scholarship committee as outstanding, are eligible; for team competitions, the application is limited to one individual per case. Applicants must attach a waiver declaration from other team members. (Applicants may also select the Excellence Scholarship; if not selected for this award, they will automatically be considered for the Excellence Scholarship application review list.)
 - (2) The student's GPA of the previous two semesters must be above 2.44. If the students are

studying in their freshman year, transcript of the previous semester shall be provided.

(3) The student's conduct performance of the previous two semesters must be above B. If the students are studying in their freshman year, transcript of the previous semester shall be provided.

(4) Scholarship recipients are required to attend the award ceremony in person, unless prevented by force majeure.

12. Outstanding Scholarship: (Priority will be given to those who meet all the following criteria and are willing to assist the Association in organizing related activities.)

(1) Recipients of awards in off-campus professional competitions, with achievements reported and announced by the Department prior to application and recognized by the department's scholarship committee as outstanding, are eligible. For team competitions, the application is limited to one individual per case. Applicants must attach a waiver declaration from other team members. (Applicants may also opt for the Excellence Scholarship; if not selected for this specific scholarship, they will automatically be considered for the Excellence Scholarship application review list.)

(2) The student's GPA of the previous two semesters must be above 2.44. If the students are studying in their freshman year, transcript of the previous semester shall be provided.

(3) The student's conduct performance of the previous two semesters must be above B. If the students are studying in their freshman year, transcript of the previous semester shall be provided.

(4) Scholarship recipients are required to attend the award ceremony in person, unless prevented by force majeure.

13. Excellent Scholarship: (Priority will be given to those who meet all the following criteria and are willing to assist the Association in organizing related activities.)

(1) Those who served enthusiastically or made outstanding contributions to society or the Department, including holding positions as class or departmental student association officers.

(2) The student's GPA of the previous two semesters must be above 2.44. If the students are studying in their freshman year, transcript of the previous semester shall be provided.

(3) The student's conduct performance of the previous two semesters must be above B. If the students are studying in their freshman year, transcript of the previous semester shall be provided.

(4) Scholarship recipients are required to attend the award ceremony in person, unless prevented by force majeure.

14. Project-Oriented Competition Scholarship: (All conditions below shall be met)

(1) Matters regarding project-oriented competitions shall be addressed in accordance with regulations stipulated by the Department.

(2) Scholarship recipients are required to attend the award ceremony in person, unless prevented by force majeure.

15. Project-Oriented Competition Scholarship: (All conditions below shall be met)

(1) Recipients shall provide short-term services, submit written documents and accept evaluation from their mentors.

(2) Recipients shall be scheduled to assist the Department and the Association with alumni relations and the operational affairs of the Alumni Association.

16. Work-Study Grants: Those with serve enthusiastically.

17. Tuition and Fees Waiver for Freshmen to Seniors: Recipients shall be a GPA of 2.85 or higher for the previous semester. Students enrolled in the first semester are eligible with no academic average.

18. International Exchange Grants: The student's GPA must be above 2.44.

Article 5 Application methods

Applicants shall fill out and submit the application form along with other documents to the

Department within the given period. Late applications will not be accepted.

4. Original transcript.

5. Proof of participation in national, international or off-campus professional competitions. (In the case of a team competition, the applicant must attach a waiver from the other team members.) Evidence of dedicated service, assistance in organizing or participating in related activities, or outstanding contribution to the Association or the Department. (A document or certificate issued by the Association, the class instructor, the Department or the University.)

6. Other documents that may help with the application.

4. Elite Scholarships: Language proficiency examination transcript.

5. Tuition and Fees Waiver for Freshmen to Seniors: Attach the payment receipt to the Department.

6. International Exchange Grants: Applicants shall attach documents for applying to foreign universities for short-term research program, to the International Office of the University for student exchange programs, or other relevant proof.

Article 6 Application period

10. Elite Scholarships: Refer to the announced schedule of the Department each semester.

11. Exceptional Scholarship: Applications shall be submitted between mid-February and early March each year.

12. Outstanding Scholarship: Applications shall be submitted between mid-February and early March each year.

13. Excellent Scholarship: Applications shall be submitted between mid-February and early March each year.

14. Project-Oriented Competition Scholarship: Refer to the relevant regulations of the Department.

15. Study Subsidy: Refer to the relevant regulations of the Department.

16. Work-Study Grants: Refer to the relevant regulations of the Department.

17. Tuition and Fees Waiver for Freshmen to Seniors: Refer to the announced schedule of the Department each semester.

18. International Exchange Grants: Applications must be submitted by March 15 of the student's fourth or sixth semester.

Article 7 Evaluation methods

10. Elite Scholarship: The Chair of the Department is authorized to convene a review committee (including a representative from the Association) to conduct the review and selection process.

11. Exceptional Scholarship: The Chair of the Department is authorized to convene a review committee (including a representative from the Association) to conduct the review and selection process.

12. Outstanding Scholarship: The Chair of the Department is authorized to convene a review committee (including a representative from the Association) to conduct the review and selection process.

13. Excellent Scholarship: The Chair of the Department is authorized to convene a review committee (including a representative from the Association) to conduct the review and selection process.

14. Project-Oriented Competition Scholarship: Refer to the relevant regulations of the Department.

15. Study Subsidy: Approved by the Chair of the Department.

16. Tuition and Fees Waiver for Freshmen to Seniors: Approved by the Chair of the Department.

17. International Exchange Grants: The Chair of the Department is authorized to convene a review committee (including a representative from the Association) to conduct the review and selection process.

18. The aforementioned scholarships shall not be given repeatedly.

Article 8 Awarding

5. Scholarship: The Association shall award scholarships and certificates of recognition at graduation ceremonies or other public occasions.
6. Study Subsidy: Students shall receive monthly scholarships based on the services they provide at the Association.
7. Tuition and Fees Waiver for Freshmen to Seniors: The Department shall handle the waiver process.
8. International Exchange Grants: Recipients are required to study abroad at the approved time and return after completing the exchange program or short-term training, and submit the application form and relevant documents for verification of the completion of the exchange program or short-term training.

Article 9 These regulations shall be implemented following approvals of the Association meetings. The same procedure shall be carried out when amendments are to be made.
